

Building Reading SKills - CWS > Parent Info Sheet

This reading program supports learners in grades 6–8 who are reading below grade level. It combines group activities with one-on-one or small-group reading support, focusing on phonics, vocabulary, fluency, comprehension, and writing through engaging activities. In each session, learners participate in group activities, reading aloud to their tutor.

Sessions are held in person on **Wednesdays**, **4:00 pm to 5:30 pm**, from November 5th and runs through to early May 2026.
